Description

Ask those questions you always wanted to ask about working in real life

The breadth, variety and diversity of Kent & Medway STEM Ambassadors will enable students to gain knowledge of a wider range of careers than ever before. Speed Networking allows a snapshot view of many different careers to be gathered, either focused across STEM or specific to a subject or industry.

Suggested Itinerary

1-1.5hrs, 1 STEM Ambassador per student group of 3-4

Each STEM Ambassador has a table; some may bring props or flyers with them. Students move around the room talking to a number of STEM Ambassadors for 10-15 minutes each.

The students can quiz STEM Ambassadors about their job role with pre-prepared organised questions or the STEM Ambassador can simply explain what they do in their occupation and their career pathway.

AMBASSADORS

Description

The session allows students to interact with STEM Ambassadors, ask questions, find out more about STEM Ambassadors and why they have chosen their given career.

This activity enables the students to meet and converse with a wide range of STEM Ambassadors in a short space of time. STEM Ambassadors talk about what they do for an occupation and are asked questions by the students about their career pathway.

STEM Ambassador Role

STEM Ambassadors will have a table or area where the students will visit them for 10-15 minutes in groups of 3-4. STEM Ambassadors can bring fliers, props or posters from their workplace to share with the students.
